Farmland Preservation:	D	- No farmland development rights purchased in more than a year. + Some under consideration.
Drinking Water Protection:	D	- Approves high density and other development in Pine Barrens.
Land Use Planning and Regulation:	B	+ Has begun process of amending loophole loaded zoning codes.
Administration and Execution:	C	- Still hasn't punished political pal for clearing & building in Pine Barrens Core. + Took lead to approve enforcement legislation.
Progress on Priority Acquisitions:	D	- Little progress on top ten list over past year. - Suffolk slows purchases.

OVERALL COMMENTS

- Proposed Zoning Code Amendments very useful.
- High density development being permitted in groundwater areas.
- Upzoning & downzoning are occurring simultaneously.
