Drinking Water Protection:	D	- Ongoing studies are no substitute for AWOL Water Protection Plan. + Exploring MTBE legal strategy.
Land Use Planning and Regulation:	F	- Comprehensive Plan Update going slowly.
Administration and Execution:	A-	+ Limited moratorium in place. + Borrows from EFC & has a good line of credit.
Progress on Priority Acquisitions:	B	+ Three and a half priorities preserved. - Town disputes need to act on some parcels.
